GUIDELINES FOR YOUTH TRIPS/ACTIVITIES/SPONSORS

Youth Trips

- * Swim suits: Girls: One-piece...if two-piece, a dark T-shirt, thigh length, must be worn over the swim suit.
Boys: No Speedo swim trunks.
- * Shorts length should be mid-thigh.
- * T-shirts can not advertise, support, or promote anything reflecting bad taste.
- * No obscene or disrespectful words.
- * Revised permission slips:
Guidelines/expectations printed on the back of permission slips.
Permission slips must be turned in on time or youth cannot attend activity.
Have signed permission slips on hand with each sponsor assigned to youth.
- * Consequences
There will be consequences suitable to the offense for those who do not follow rules. If the action is serious enough to warrant a youth be sent home, parents will be contacted, and will be responsible for the cost of the return trip.

Activities/General Rules

- * Boys/Girls no romantic display of affection beyond holding hands.
- * Keep out of the custodian's office and do not use the phone in the kitchen.
- * Overnight activities
Must abide by "lights out" rules. Curfew times are expected to be followed.
- * No youth roaming in halls/parking lots.
Adults are to encourage youth to attend activities or leave the property.
- * Youth are not allowed in the church building without an adult sponsor.

Sponsors

- * Speeding - Sponsors should set examples by obeying traffic laws.
- * Seatbelts worn - Each rider must be wearing a seatbelt.
- * Lights out - Sponsors should enforce.
- * Same gender sponsors
Sponsors of the same gender are expected. If a same gender sponsor is not available, a parent of that particular gender will be contacted to attend, or that gender will not attend activity.
- * Maps & itineraries will be provided for events away from the church property.
Sponsors will adhere to the itinerary. There will be a clear plan before leaving on trips. Sponsors must travel in a group or use cellular phones for communication between vehicles.
- * Sponsors agree on discipline and are expected to adhere to guidelines.
Serious issues should be passed on to the Youth Minister.
- * Horseplay will be limited:
Adults must set and keep limits, not allowing practical jokes to get out of hand.
Adults are expected to know what the limits are.
No food fights.
